Moscow sights



Zaryadye Park

This public park, within a few minutes' walking distance from the Kremlin, is one of Moscow's cultural centres providing education and entertainment in many guises. It is situated in the historic district of the same name and was built on the site of the Rossiya hotel that was demolished in 2006. The park and centre cover 13 hectars between Kitaigorodsky Proezd, Ulitsa Varvarka and Moskvoretsakaya Naberezhnaya.



Christ the Saviour Cathedral is a Russian orthodox church on Ulitsa Volkhonka, on the north bank of the Moscow river. It was built between 1990 and 1995 and is a faithful copy of the cathedral of the same name that was destroyed in 1931. At 103m high, it is the third tallest orthodox church in the world after the People's Salvation Cathedral in Bucharest (Romania) and the Peter and Paul Cathedral in St. Petersburg.

It was in Moscow that Tchaikowsky's "1812 Overture" was heard for the first time.

The People's Republic of China, a very populated country, is located in the east of Asia. Its diverse landscapes, ranging from steppes, deserts, mountains, lakes and large rivers to the 14,000 km long coastline, inspire visitors again and again.

The cities have a modern architecture, but they try to preserve at least the old quarters and historical sites.

The capital Beijing has about 1,402 billion inhabitants and is the cultural, economic and communication centre of the country,

The currency is the Yuan (1 US = 6.418 yuan).

The official language is Chinese (standard), the spelling is "simplified" Chinese.

91.1% of the population are Han Chinese.

The head of state is President Xi Jinping.

Shanghai is the industrial centre and Hong Kong is the leading commercial centre and port





93rd INTERNATIONAL F.I.C.C. RALLY 2023 from 24 JUNE to 3 JULY in KOZIENICE/POLAND





Kozienice is not yet as well known as many other towns in Poland, but it is a small, lively place that is opening up to tourism and is certainly worth a visit.

The small town is located only 40 km from Warsaw and is the administrative seat of the Gmina and the powlat Koznienice. The population is about 18,000.

The name of the town is based on the Jewish name Kozhnitz (in German Koschnitz) and received its town charter in 1549. However, the history of the town can be traced back to 1206.

Kozienice has three sister towns: Göllheim in Germany, Chuhuiv (Ukraine) and Medzilaborce (Slovakia).

Camping/Caravanning/Motorcaravanning

Spain: According to data from the INE (Instituto Nacional de Estadistica) and FECC (Federacion Espanola de Campings – Spanish Camping Federation), camping holidays have been just as popular with Spaniards over these past two years as they were in 2019. Spanish campers reckoned that camping offered the best value and safest of all types of holiday and campsites were top of their list in terms of accommodation. The number of nights spent on campsites in the first 6 months of 2021 was over 8.5 million.

Italy: On 5 August, the Council of Ministers decided that outdoor accommodation (includes campsites) are no longer obliged to demand a "Green Pass". This also applies to on-site restaurants. (Decree of 23 July 2021 N° 105 published in the official journal).

Germany: German holidaymakers have been as enthusiastic as ever about caravanning in 2021. New registrations for leisure vehicles have increased by more than 6% since the beginning of the year. Around 75,000 leisure vehicles were registered in Germany between January and July – more than ever before over the same period.

Exports of German leisure vehicles are back to the "pre-Corona" level.

In the first half of the year exports of German caravans and motorcaravans rose sharply. Last year, many European countries restricted travel abroad because of the corona pandemic. German leisure vehicle production rose significantly in 2021, having of necessity been scaled down the previous year during the height of the pandemic, and output is once more up to record "pre-Corona" levels. However the caravanning industry now has to contend with delivery problems, since production is being affected by faltering supply chains and a lack of spare parts and raw materials.

There is however an increase in sales of second-hand caravans and motorcaravans. Used caravans and motorcaravans have been selling like "hot cakes" in 2021. In the first seven months of the year over 100,000 leisure vehicles changed hands. That represents an increase of 1.4% compared with the previous year. Together with the increase in new registrations, this has had an effect on the vehicle stock as a whole: it reached a new peak of 1.4 million vehicles.

Back to record-breaking facts and figures: the increase in sales in the caravanning sector in the first half of the year.

Turnover in the caravanning sector rose by more than 21% in the first half of the year following the decline in the first half of 2020 thanks to the pandemic. Altogether the sector has reported 6.8 billion euros since January and has thus already witnessed the best six months of its history. In addition, it is set to end 2021 with new record-breaking figures.

China: There were record numbers of visitors to the 10th "All in Caravaning" in Beijing (held over 3 days): 25,448 visitors (6% more than the previous year) were attracted by 200 exhibitors at the 39,000 sqm exhibition centre.

The **Caravaning Industrie Verband (CIVD)** has received the German Brand Award 2021 in the category of Excellent Brand Non-Governmental-Organization. The award is in recognition of the caravanning federation's crossmedia image campaign that advertises camping as a very desirable type of holiday.

Store summer tyres properly

Before they go on winter holiday, they should be thoroughly cleaned and inflated by about half a bar above the manufacturer's specification. As a "holiday home" they prefer a cool, dry and dark environment. Contact with oil/grease or solvents should be avoided. Tyres without rims are best stacked horizontally on top of each other - up to a maximum height of four. Complete tyres - i.e. tyres mounted on rims - ideally find their winter rest on a rim tree where they are stacked on top of each other without contact, or on special wall brackets which help them to nestle narrowly and space-savingly against the garage or cellar wall. Practical tips – for campers too

Coffee stains on items of clothing or a tablecloth respond well to damp salt. Leave moistened salt on the stains for a few hours and then rinse in warm water.

If a **necklace chain gets knotted**, leave it in oil for a short time, then rinse in warm soapy water and the knots will unravel. (read somewhere)

MISCELLANEOUS

Traffic

Great Britain: Passports mandatory from 1 October 2021

An ID card is no longer acceptable for trips to Great Britain (even for Christmas shopping in London). Thanks to Brexit everyone needs to show a passport.

It is safer on foot or on a bike in the dark

It is important to be able to see and to be seen. There is an amazing range of accessories on the market now such as caps and hats with an integrated light (the battery lasts up to 4 hours), gloves that glow in the dark and recharge in daylight, reflecting clips that can be attached to shoes or a jogging jacket and all manner of bike lamps (new models, new colours).

According to ADAC if pedestrians wear reflective clothing they can be seen 140m away. When buying reflective material, check the label for the standard "EN ISO 20471" or "EN1150". Cyclists should check their lights every time they go out and make sure that the mandatory six reflectors are in place.

Legal matters

In Germany, hotels and other hospitality reception staff are not allowed to photocopy **a persons's ID** or even request to keep it temporarily. It is only the police, public order office/regulatory agency (das Ordnungsamt), tax evasion authority or customs authority that have the right to demand this document. It is acceptable to show one's person ID briefly for identification purposes, but nothing more because fraudsters and confidence tricksters can pick up and use your details very quickly.



<u>Health</u>

Protection from the common cold or chill: **Zinc** – this trace element has anti-inflammatory properties. A dose of 75mg per day (adults) can reduce the time that a cold hangs around. **Honey and thyme** (exist in tablet form) soothe cold symptoms – especially a bad cough.

The part of one's body that heals the quickest is the **tongue**. Special cells in the mouth speed up the healing process more quickly than on any other area of skin.

100 years of insulin: Insulin is a life-saver now unlike a century ago when diabetes was a death sentence. Two Canadian researchers, Frederick Grant Banting and Charles Best, succeeded in manufacturing insulin in 1921. These days diabetics generally manage their own treatment.

Curious facts/Environment/Culture

The famous **Beaufort 21** exhibition on the Belgian coast comes to an end at the beginning of November. Every year, over the summer months, internationally renowned artists display their work at various outdoor venues along the coast.

INTERESTING NEWS FROM F.I.C.C. AND ITS MEMBERS

According to a "Weighing Campaign" carried out by **NKC** (**NL**), one in three caravans are overloaded. Excess weight can affect driving stability, impair braking ability and ultimately cause an accident. In addition, overloading is a punishable offence. Many caravan owners were completely



unaware that they were overloaded. 44% were 100 kgs overweight, 28% of whom were more than 200 kgs over the limit.

October also saw the Camperdriving experience, which **NKC** organises annually so that members can learn to drive motorhomes or improve their driving skills.

UNWTO has organised a competition for students worldwide on the theme "**Ideas that will make tourism more responsible and sustainable**". Special emphasis was given to environmentally harmful plastic pollutants as well as encouraging the contribution of tourism to the development of rural areas.

Around 1,000 students from 124 educational institutions in 45 countries entered the competition. Convincing and highly praised ideas and solutions included works of art, calls to action, instagram and other digital marketing campaigns as well as potential strategies to help reduce the use of plastics and plastic waste in the two branches of the tourism industry - travel and hospitality.
