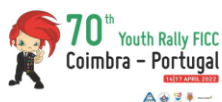

92nd INTERNATIONAL F.I.C.C. RALLY 2022 from 28 September to 7 October in CHINA

Thanks to the continuing pandemic and increased restrictions on travellers arriving in China, the organisers, 21RV, in agreement with F.I.C.C. have **decided to suspend this Rally until a final decision is taken end of April 2022**.



China (Chinese People's Republic) is the third biggest state in the world.

Capital city: Beijing

The country is predominantly mountainous and some of its mountain ranges are over 7590m.

The north Chinese coast is flat whereas the southern coast is hilly with many inlets and islands. There are two major rivers, the Huangho and the Yangtsekiang, that partly characterize the landscape.

The country experiences a variety of weather patterns.

Numerous tree species originated in China i.e. orange, mandarine, mulberry and Chinese lacquer tree.

The population is 94% Chinese, the remainder comprising mountain people, Mongolians and Tibetans.

The National People's Congress is the supreme organ of state power.

School attendance is compulsory as is military service.

There are a number of religions in China: essentially the old Chinese cults of ancestor and nature worship, Buddhism and Taoism all coexist. Many Chinese espouse more than one religion. Islam is fairly widespread, Christianity less so.

The history of China is ancient and extremely interesting. It begins after Asian pre-historic times with the old Chinese empire 1800 – 1050 BC, leading into the new Chinese empire that lasted until 1912. China was a republic until 1948. The People's Republic came into being in Beijing, the new capital city, on 1 October 1949.

When Marco Polo discovered China for the western world, Cathay in the north and Manzi in the south had been united under Kublai Khan.

Chinese culture is wide-ranging and embraces philosophy, calligraphy, fine arts, music, painting, etc.

The Chinese invented paper-making, the compass, printing and gunpowder centuries before the western world did.

Chinese is the most important of the Indo-Chinese languages. Root words are monosyllabic and are grammatically invariable. Every character represents a whole word. There are some 50,000 characters in all, but between 2,000 and 4,000 are enough for everyday use. A new style of writing introduced in 1956 reads from left to right and 800 characters were simplified.



The Great Wall of China (Wan-li Ch'ang-ch'eng), constructed between 221-210 B.C. and repaired in the 15C, has become the symbol of China. It starts in Sutchou in Kansu and continues east to the Gulf of Liaotung with myriad two-storey fortified towers and gates along its length.

But China has also inspired western writers. The older generation will remember devouring the novels of the prolific American writer Pearl Buck who introduced us to this mysterious country, its customs and traditions. Her books include "The Good Earth", "Dragon Seed", "China Sky", "Pavilion of Women", "The Devil ever Sleeps".

Some of her books were made into films. Pearl Buck was awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature in 1938.

This rally might perhaps tempt some of us to re-visit one of her books and immerse ourselves in interesting and entertaining stories about China.

Special circumstances have resulted in the Rally venue being transferred from Kozienice to Staszow.

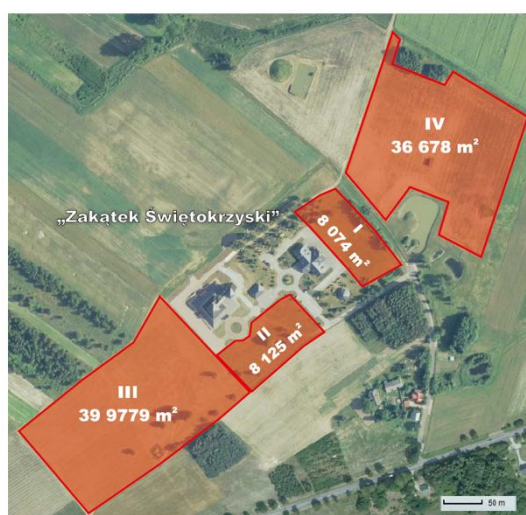
This change will however be submitted to the F.I.C.C. General Assembly 2022 for its approval.

The town and municipality of Staszow is situated in the south-east of Poland in the Kielce-Sandomierz

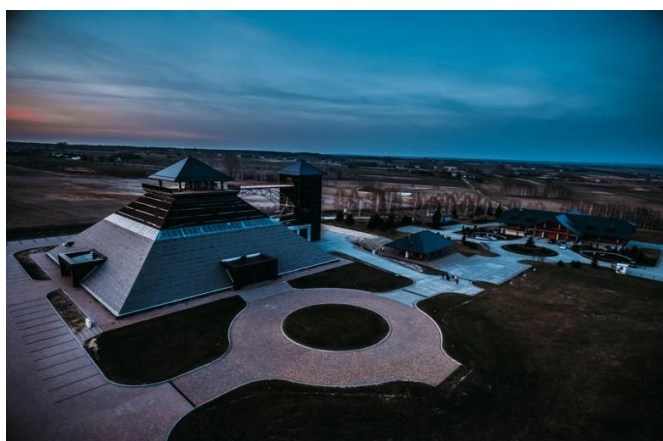
Highlands, on the Czarna Staszowska river and at the foot of the Swietokrzyskie mountains (approx. 200 kms south-east of Warsaw).

The town is 199m above sea level and has a population of 16,000.

The rally site (about 4 kms from the town) is on firm grass-covered ground and can accommodate about 1,000 outfits. It has all the facilities and infrastructure necessary for hosting a very good event.

94th INTERNATIONAL F.I.C.C. RALLY 2024 in SOUTH KOREA

Organised by
KCCF (Korea Camping & Caravanning Federation)

Under the slogan: “Health and Harmony for all Campers”

The rally venue that is being proposed is Yeoncheon-Gun in the province of Gyeonggi. This province is adjacent to the border with North Korea and the idea is that holding the rally there would constitute a gesture towards world peace, especially as regards the Korean peninsula.

Yeoncheon is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site thanks to local geological features and prehistoric sites and museums. The Imjin river that flows into North Korea is one of the town's attractions.

The rally venue has all the facilities necessary for hosting an international event.

The project has the wholehearted support of the town, the province and the government.

A post-rally project is also envisaged in the form of a trip to North Korea with a special programme for campers in the interests of strengthening peace initiatives between South and North Korea.



Camping/Caravanning/Motorcaravanning

The A to Z of safe loading before your trip

Overloading will adversely affect a vehicle's driving behaviour and safety

Checklist:

What are the vehicle's unladen weight and maximum laden weight?

What is the maximum payload?



Are there additional (heavy) accessories in your motorcaravan not included in the vehicle's unladen weight?

Where can I make savings on weight?

What food do I have to take and what can I buy at my destination or en route?

What changes can I make?

Do I need to have a full tank of water or can I manage with a reduced quantity?

Is the waste water tank empty?

Calculating the load

This is when a quick look at the vehicle registration certificate is useful. It gives the unladen weight (under G in the registration certificate) that, in compliance with EU regulation 1230/2012, includes fuel, gas and the weight of the driver (75kgs). To calculate the load, you must subtract the unladen weight of the motorcaravan from the maximum laden weight (under F.2 in the registration certificate). The unladen weight and the load added together should not exceed the permissible maximum laden weight.

A word of warning: If additional equipment is acquired then the unladen weight may well exceed that given under G. So it is worth checking the unladen weight on a weighbridge (scale).

Overloading a motorcaravan should be avoided at all costs because fines can be imposed in your home country and abroad. Also remember that if the excess weight is way above the permissible maximum laden weight then your insurance company may refuse to consider a claim and pay damages in the event of an accident!

Packing and loading

To reduce swaying in your motorcaravan always stow heavy items low down. If the motorcaravan has a double floor, stow heavy items underneath between the axles. Only put lightweight items in the wall cuboards. Generally speaking nothing should be left lying around and pets should not be free to move around either. Dogs and cats should be properly installed in a travel box or basket.

What should I take?

The weight of individual items adds up very quickly. You can save weight with lightweight camping tables and chairs, aluminium gas bottles and by carefully planning your packing. And it does make sense only to fill up the water tank once you arrive at your holiday destination.

Payload – a purchase decision?

Equipment plays a crucial part when purchasing a motorcaravan: how many will it seat or sleep, how big are the beds or the wet cell, the interior design, equipment and all-in price - these are the decisive purchasing criteria. But it is rare that anyone will focus on the payload!!

Important: A day or so before setting off you should take your loaded motorcaravan to a weighbridge (arrange this in advance at a builders merchant's or an agricultural supply depot) and if you find that you are overloaded then have a bit of a re-think and a clear-out!

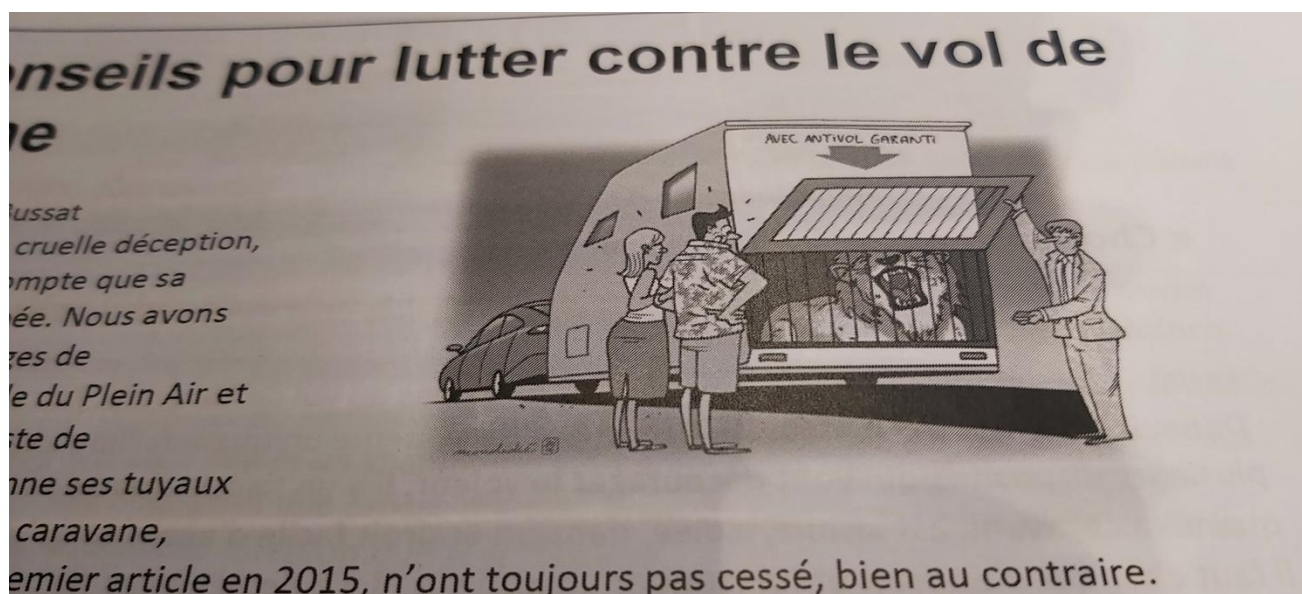
Hints on avoiding caravan theft

Despite precautionary measures such as a chain that blocks the handle of the coupling head and putting a metal ball in the hole to block it completely, corner steadies that are lowered to immobilise the coupling, all these are good measures in themselves, but are not enough to deter thieves if, for example, the jockey wheel is still visible which will enable thieves to move the caravan and "take it with them".



Anti-theft measures such as covering the coupling head and a wheel clamp are indispensable. It is also important that any anti-theft devices should be very visible so as to discourage amateur thieves from taking their chance and show professional villains that they will have difficulty claiming their booty. Immobilising the coupling head makes theft very much more difficult. According to the experts, anti-theft devices that are difficult to install are the very ones that cause thieves most problems and that they know are best to avoid.

In France

Camping is allowed anywhere on private land provided that there is no indication to the contrary, but the length of stay – or to put it more precisely the annual length of stay – may not exceed three months. However parking a mobile home is not permitted, only tents, caravans and motorcaravans.

Practical tips – for campers too

Smoke alarms must be kept dust-free at all times since the sensor cannot detect smoke if there is a build-up of dust. Experts recommend removing dirt and dust with a damp cloth or a feather duster. Warning: Suction and blowing devices should never be used on smoke alarms because the airstream could trigger the electrics inside.

Campers like wearing **white socks** but they tend to go yellow in time. They will regain their sparkling white appearance if you add 1 or 2 sachets of baking powder to the main wash. Otherwise the following can also help: dissolve a dishwasher tab in a spoonful of hot water and leave the socks to soak for a few hours. Rinse thoroughly or wash in the machine in the normal way.

MISCELLANEOUS

Traffic

Austria: Toll charges have been increased for the Bosruck and Gleinalm tunnels on the A9 Pyhrn Autobahn between Linz and Graz. The A9 combined ticket for both tunnels costs Euro 15.50. The Gleinalm tunnel alone costs Euro 9.50 and the Bosruck tunnel 6 Euro. All of these prices are valid for caravan outfits too. Digital toll tickets also apply on the Brenner and Tauern motorways, the Albergstrasse and Karawanken tunnel, but only for vehicles travelling south.

The new digital toll ticket was introduced in 2021 and means that drivers who have purchased their ticket online can pass through the toll stations without having to stop, using the Prepaid Only lane marked in green. For them the barriers open automatically. One can of course still pay tolls in the usual way.

Great Britain: In the interests of increased security, London has installed 73 CCTV video cameras per 1,000 inhabitants and is therefore the most widely monitored capital city in Europe. It has more cameras than Beijing that “only” has 55. Berlin (D) has just 6 cameras per 1,000 inhabitants.

Netherlands: Amsterdam’s Schiphol airport will soon be the proud owners of 20 pigs brought in to protect birds. The pigs’ role will be to ensure that birds do not come too close to aircraft and at the same time they will feed on the grass and keep it short. This means no food for the birds and wild geese to eat so they will stay away and collisions between aircraft and birds thus avoided. It is worth a try!

Health

One hears increasing talk about **liberalising hashish**. But hashish does make a person physically dependent and, despite claims to the contrary, one out of every two people who smoke “weed” on a daily basis, becomes addicted.

Medication beyond its expiry date can be dangerous. A head-ache pill that smells of vinegar is no good. Out-of-date antibiotics can encourage development of resistance against antibiotics. Syrups



and cough mixture should not be used after their expiry dates either. Creams too can become rancid. And be very careful with eye drops – when out-of-date they can irritate the eyes. Once opened, eye drops should generally be used within four weeks. Do not dispose of expired medication yourself but return it to a pharmacy or some other proper collection point.

A New Year's resolution: **10,000 paces a day** for your health! (Suggestion from the World Health Organisation).

That amounts to between six and eight kilometers – realistically one might manage half of WHO's recommendation, but moving is important because it helps prevent pain and reduces stress levels. Above all, walking is good for anyone who is trying to lose weight.

Curious facts/Environment/Culture

According to the IUCN (International Union for the Conservation of Nature) stocks of **red tuna** have risen by approx. 20% over the past few years. This is the result of imposing sustainable catch quotas and the ongoing fight against illegal fishing.

In the Badain Jaran desert of **north-west China**, there are 74 lakes that never dry up because they are fed by underground springs the water for which originates in melted snow in mountainous regions.

Nothing, apart from toilet paper, sour milk or water from flowers, should be disposed of in a **WC**. Cotton buds, cigarette ends, wet wipes, remains of food, medication, oil, tampons etc not only block the waste pipes but toxic substances in them cannot be filtered out in sewage treatment plants. Such substances harm micro-organisms in inshore waters and can even penetrate drinking water supplies.

All of the above-mentioned items should always be disposed of properly not only to protect technical equipment and infrastructure but the environment as a whole.

Sea turtles are under threat but, with the help and commitment of amateur conservationists, efforts are being made to avoid their extinction. They are the oldest living reptiles still around: they have populated the world's oceans for 225 million years and are able to stay under water without surfacing to breathe for seven hours. The shell of adult turtles can measure up to a metre and they sometimes weigh up to 185 kgs.

Norway: The new futuristic **Edvard Munch** museum opened in Oslo in October 2021. It has thirteen storeys covering some 26,000 sq.m. where the artist's works, including his most famous "The Scream", are displayed.

Morio CHEN, founder of The Camping Association of the Republic of China (CAROC) and its President in 1991, died last month.



It was Morio Chen who set up the Formosa Camping and Caravanning Club in 2000, became its President from 2004 to 2010 and was subsequently made Honorary President of the Club.

Morio Chen was born in Taiwan in 1945. He graduated from the Agricultural College of Kyoto University (Japan) and held a PhD from the Graduate School of Agriculture. He was nominated Assistant Professor at Taiwan Normal University in 2013.

Morio Chen designed a number of nature-orientated campsites in Taiwan and Japan.

He was a very educated gentleman who loved art and music. Apart from Chinese, he also spoke fluent Japanese and English.

Morio Chen was a very enthusiastic participant at International F.I.C.C. Rallies and attended 36 in all. In addition, he was always very involved in international events organised in Taiwan.

He frequently represented his Club as its delegate at F.I.C.C. General Assemblies.

Overseas campers came to know and love Taiwanese hospitality through Morio and were thoroughly pampered not only by him, but by the entire family who made their guests feel at home.

Morio was a very special person – jovial, polite, discrete, intelligent, open-minded.

We offer our sincere condolences to his partner Sue, his children, brothers and sisters.

Morio Chen will long be remembered by those who knew him and appreciated his company and he will certainly be missed at our future rallies.

50 Years of F.I.C.C. Membership



SF Caravan ry (Finland) is celebrating 50 years of F.I.C.C. membership in 2022

SF Caravan was originally founded in 1964 when it was known as Caravan Federation SF Caravan (**Asuntovaunuyhdistys SF Caravan**). Its name was changed to SF Caravan ry in 1988. SF Caravan is a nationwide organisation comprising local clubs. All club members have their own membership number that can be displayed on their vehicle.

The General Assembly is the supreme authority of the Federation and has only been held once a year since 2012. The Federation's Council is elected for three years and comprises a chairman and eight members.

Its registered office is in Hämeenlinna.

SF Caravan became a member of F.I.C.C. in 1972 and has organised a number of international F.I.C.C. rallies including 1981 in Tampere, 1994 in Joensuu, 2004 in Oulu and 2014 in Pori.

The 61st International Youth Rally was held in Helsinki in 2011 and was the most northerly event ever held by F.I.C.C.'s young campers.

The best known Finns within F.I.C.C. are certainly Mr. Lars Dahlberg, President of F.I.C.C. from 1996-2005, Eero Ollila, F.I.C.C. Council Member from 2005-2011, Minna Joensuu (. – 2020) and now Olli Rusi (2020 -)

SF-Caravan's "raison d'être" is to guarantee its members maximum joy and benefits from their camping activities. Changing holiday practices, habits and interests will determine the way forward for the federation. Official decisions, European directives, laws, decrees and regulations will define the direction that campers and caravanners will be taking.
