Gas grills and barbecues need proper checking over

It is important to check whether the tubing has any hairline cracks or shows signs of being perished. If this is the case then it needs to be replaced straightaway. The pressure regulator also needs to be examined to make sure there are no particles or foreign bodies in the connecting valves.

Gas tubing and pressure regulators should be replaced at least every ten years.

When checking the connections, secure the tubing linking the grill to the gas bottle. Mix equal quantities of water and detergent and wipe over the tubing connections then open the valve on the gas bottle and if air bubbles form you know there is a leak somewhere. Cleaning the grill is best undertaken with the grill on the highest setting and the lid closed so that the accumulated fat and grease can burn off.

Legionella bacteria (Legionnaire’s disease) – a potential danger for campers – so here are some tips on how to avoid this serious and possibly fatal illness.

- ° Clean the shower head in your caravan/motorcaravan very thoroughly once a year.
- ° Heat up the water heater to 60° at least once a week.
- ° Empty the water tank if you have not used your caravan/motorcaravan for more than a week.
- ° Fill up the tank and the water heater at least once a year and add 50 ml of liquid chlorine per 100 l of water. If you make the solution more concentrated you will get a smell of chlorine that is difficult to eliminate. Run the solution through the taps (faucets) and tubes, rinse through the pipes and leave the chlorinated water in the system for 24 hours. Then empty the whole system and rinse out thoroughly.
- ° Chlorine is of no use if the tank is very dirty – chlorine disinfects but it is not a cleaning agent. So you need to use a cleaning agent (detergent) first and only disinfect with chlorine afterwards.
- ° Do not fill up your water tank using a water hose that is supplied, but bring and use your own hose that you keep in a plastic bag or case. Use this hose exclusively for filling your water tank and remember to clean it regularly. Also let water flow out through the hose briefly before inserting it into the water tank opening. If the hose is difficult to clean then it is definitely time to throw it away and replace it.
- ° If an existing hose cannot be removed from a water dispensing point, then you should look for another tapping point.
- ° Clean the hose ends and tank cap regularly with chlorine and rinse them thoroughly afterwards.
- ° Do not forget to clean the aeration outlet in the water tank i.e. the tube that is normally near the filler pipe.



Legionella bacterie do not proliferate in cold water. Remember that water in a full water tank usually remains cooler for longer than in a nearly empty tank. However, to save on weight it is better not to travel with an absolutely full tank.

Where do you get the cheapest camping deals this year?

Everything is getting more expensive – including camping.

According to a study by ADAC, an average camping family will pay 51.12€ on a campsite in the main European holiday destinations. If you have a dog, it will cost you more especially in Slovenia, Italy and Croatia.

Camping costs are highest in Switzerland, followed by Croatia, Italy, Slovenia, Spain, Great Britain, Austria, Denmark, the Netherlands, France, Germany and Sweden. Sweden is the best value where you need to reckon on 37.41€ for 2 adults, a 10-year old child, pitch rental, electricity (5kWh), hot showers and tourist tax.

Practical tips – for campers too

Campers often take their cats along with them on trips. **Cat litter** is intended to soak up moisture, prevent bad smells and should not create any dust when refilling the tray. The product should not contain any heavy metals or respirable fibres. So do read the description of contents on the packaging.

Even in a caravan or motorcaravan there are occasional problems of small particles getting caught up in the water system. To avoid **ingesting these small particles** hold a tea strainer under the nozzle of the water tap to catch them.

The new EU drivers licence is on its way....

It will be valid for just 15 years

The EU type approval has been adapted from regulations relating to heavy goods vehicles (HGV) to apply to passenger vehicles. From now on all new vehicles must be fitted with assistance systems.

- ° Accident data recorder/Blackbox/Event Data Recorder “DER”: (from 07.2024 for all passenger cars including all heavy motor vehicles from 02.2029)
- ° Warning system for driver's drop in concentration: (from 07.2026 for all vehicles)
- ° Intelligent Speed Adaptation “ISA” : (from 07.2024 for all vehicles)
- ° Driver Drowsiness and Attention Warning “DDAW” – Attention Assist: from 07.2024 for all vehicles
- ° Reversing Detection “RD”: from 07.2024 for all vehicles
- ° Cybersecurity: from 07.2024 for all vehicles including motorcaravans up to 3.5 t
- ° Advanced Emergency Braking System with Emergency-Stop Signal “AEBS + ESS” – City Safety, Pedestrian Emergency Braking System: (from 07.2024 for all passenger cars and light goods and utility vehicles)
- ° Development of an emergency braking system: (from 07.2026 for all passenger cars and light goods and utility vehicles)
- ° Lane Keep Assist “LKA” – Lane Departure Avoidance “LDA”, Lane Departure Protection “LPD”: (from 07.2024 for all passenger cars and light utility vehicles)

Regarding heavy motor vehicles over 3.5 t, including motorcaravans

- ° Collision warning system for pedestrians and cyclists – Blind Spot Information System for the detection of Bicycles “BSIS”: (from 07.2024 for all passenger cars and light utility vehicles)
- ° Blind Spot Assist: (from 07.2024 for all heavy motor vehicles)
- ° EU type approval mandatory for automatic vehicles: (from 07.07.2024 for all automatic vehicles).

Health

Egg cartons should only be used once. They are difficult to clean and chicken waste on eggshells can stick to the cardboard container allowing salmonella to spread very quickly.

Water in a kettle etc should not be reheated because after it has been left to stand for any length of time, harmful residues from the kettle material can build up in the water. If your kettle is made of stainless steel there might be traces of nickel that can lead to an allergic reaction in some people.

First Aid for a nosebleed : In an acute case, bend the person's head forwards. This causes blood pressure to fall and stops the bleeding. Do not move the head backwards (towards the back of the neck) because blood will trickle down through the esophagus and could cause vomiting. A cold compress on the neck can help however because this causes a reflex action making the blood vessels in the nose contract which also helps stop the blood flow. If this does not work, pinch the nose for a few minutes.

If the nose is still bleeding after about 20 minutes, seek the advice of a doctor in case there is a serious underlying medical condition.

The **narrowest house in Europe** is in Bregenz/Austria. The façade of the house on Kirchstrasse is just 57 cm wide.

The red patch or spot on the underneath of the beak of grey and other **seagulls** is thought to be an aid for young birds. They peck at this particular spot to show that they are hungry.

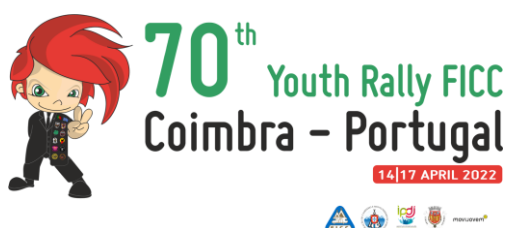
