

F.I.C.C. WORLD CAMPING FESTIVAL 2023 AT ZATON HOLIDAY RESORT/CROATIA



The World Camping Festival took place at the Zaton Holiday Resort, Zadar, Croatia from the 23rd of June to the 1st of July 2023 and was organised by the F.I.C.C. in cooperation with Touristhotel group to replace the cancelled 93rd F.I.C.C. International Rally, which had been due to take place in Poland at a similar time. 584 Adults and 102 young people from 23 countries took part. Members were offered the opportunity to stay in their own units, holiday homes or apartments.

A full programme had been organised and included many of the elements normally found at an International F.I.C.C. Rally, although some were missing due to the difficulties of organising the event on a commercial site. All the usual activities, that were provided by Zaton, were available to members.

When attendees booked in at the site reception they received a "goody bag", containing a drinks flask, to commemorate World Camping Day, and a frisbee, to mark the 90th Birthday of F.I.C.C., and a site map to direct them to their allocated pitch.

On Saturday, many members took the opportunity to visit the historic city of Nin, founded in the 9th century BC, which was an important municipium in Roman times.

The Parade of Nations took place on Sunday evening, led by local drummers, and culminated in a large Amphitheatre which accommodated all the participants for the opening ceremony and evening entertainment, which followed.

Excursions had been arranged and included: a half day trip to Zadar, a full day excursion to Krka National Park and boat trips to Kornati National Park and Silba Island.

Evening entertainment took place nightly, either in the Amphitheatre or at the beachfront bar.

The General Assembly took place in the Saturnus Disco on the Wednesday and later that afternoon, members were invited to take part in a photograph to celebrate the F.I.C.C.'s 90th Birthday.

Thursday 29th of June was International Camping Day and a ceremony was held with International and local dignitaries present.

The Closing Ceremony and Farewell Party, on Friday evening which were due to take place on the beach, were disrupted by the only inclement weather of the Festival when they had to be moved at short notice to an undercover area due to a threatening thunderstorm, which despite increased winds never arrived.



Speech of the F.I.C.C. President Mr. Joao Alves Pereira

Dear Guests, Ladies and Gentlemen,

Today, 29 June 2023, F.I.C.C. celebrates for the first time the World Camping Day, whose official recognition has not only been confirmed by UNWTO but also endorsed as one of the trendiest forms of tourism.

It is my pleasure to convey, on behalf of the World Tourism Organization, our sincere congratulations to the host and to the organizers of this amazing World Camping Festival 2023, as well as our warm greetings to all of you the enthusiastic participants.

This is not simply a new edition of the Festival, but a special one, as it is coincident with the 90th anniversary of the International Federation of Camping and Caravanning – which is an outstanding and very active affiliate member of UNWTO.



Therefore, I am pleased to extend our warm congratulations to the management of the International Federation and to all its members and supporters on this significant anniversary.

It is also extremely pleasant to underline that, thanks to the efforts of your Federation, today
we are celebrating the very first World Camping Day, which is a great example of successful
initiative to raise awareness globally on the rich connection of tourism with nature and on its
potential to contribute to a more sustainable tourism sector.

From UNWTO we always welcome such relevant activities organized by our Affiliate Members. And today I am here to bring our institutional support to your valuable initiative to celebrate this great event, which is offering to all of us an excellent framework to exchange views and experiences, contributing in this way to the much necessary debate on how to better adapt tourism to the new challenges.

The World Camping Festival is for UNWTO an extremely relevant global tourism event, and for this reason was included in the UNWTO Affiliate Members Programme of Work for 2023.

Tourism current situation and forecasts

This Festival is taking place in a very **encouraging context** for the tourism industry. According to our most recent data the global tourism achieved strong and promising results in 2022, with **international arrivals reaching almost 65% of the pre-pandemic levels** and Europe strongly leading this recovery process. Furthermore, 2023 started on a very strong dynamic, as the international tourist arrivals reached globally, during the first quarter of the year, 80% of the pre-pandemic level.

And we look ahead with optimism, as our forecasts anticipate for 2023 levels closed to or even higher than those recorded in 2019, despite the geopolitical and economic challenges that we all know.

Integrating sustainability into tourism strategies

The huge impact of the crisis on tourism has put us in front of a great challenge, which is at the same time a big opportunity: to relaunch tourism on a stronger and more sustainable basis, by embedding in the new strategies and business models the main lessons learned from recent crisis and current new challenges.

And one important lesson is that the tourism sector have probably changed permanently, as travellers have become more discerning and concerned about the positive impact of their travelling choices on local communities, climate and environment. Therefore, governments and tourism private businesses must reassess how they respond to the changing expectations of their customers.

And in this journey towards long-term sustainability which tourism sector must undertake, the contributions of each segment – like the camping one- are essential, and each actor with solid experience and knowledge have an important role to play. The contribution of your International Federation is extremely important.



UNWTO and its partnership with Affiliate Members

And you can count on the firm and permanent support of the World Tourism Organization. As most of you know, our UN Agency has the institutional mission to promote the sustainable and responsible development of tourism. And in addressing this mission we consider the private sector a key partner. Because UNWTO has the institutional specificity of having as members not only the Governments, but also tourism private entities and local administration, universities, professional tourism associations etc, providing them with an effective global platform to engage in dialogue, share information and establish partnerships.

We are proud to count on a powerful network of around 500 Affiliate Members -which are leading tourism entities, a network which represents for UNWTO a permanent source of support, projects, and innovative ideas, as well as an excellent channel to bring the perspective of the private sector in the current strategic debates.

FICC - leader in promoting camping and caravanning tourism

And the International Federation of Camping and Caravanning is precisely such outstanding partners of UNWTO.

When we refer to promotion of the camping and caravanning activities, we are talking about an increasingly dynamic segment of tourism, with optimistic forecasts. One of the key factors driving this dynamic is the desire of travellers to reconnect with nature and enjoy new, authentic, healthy, green and enriching experiences.

Furthermore, due to the inflation and increase of transportation and accommodation costs, tourists increasingly look for more affordable travel options, and camping could offer such attractive alternative to the let's say "traditional" travel options.

The pandemic has also added an important factor in this equation. While international travel restrictions were put in place, many people turned to domestic travel options, with camping and caravanning providing a safe way to explore new destinations. And once travel restrictions were gradually lifted, this segment tends to maintain this dynamic and is expected to continue growing in popularity and attractiveness.

At the same time, camping is becoming a tourism specific pillar that can help destinations to diversify their offer and reduce seasonality, as well as encourage tourists to visit less known rural destinations. For so many destinations outdoor activities are now more than ever part of their holiday offer and represents a true opportunity to diversify their products and foster local economic development.

Our host -Croatia and specifically this amazing region of Zadar- are excellent example of how to successfully transform outdoor tourism in an added value of your brand.

In the process of promoting this tourism segment the role of the International Federation of Camping and Caravanning is crucial. The FICC has been a pioneer in raising awareness and developing this segment of travelling, and is being valuable partner and contributor to all the UNWTO initiatives in this field.



Within this context, I think this is an adequate opportunity for UNWTO to congratulate the President of the International Federation, Mr. Joao Alves PEREIRA for his bet on outdoor activities and for his permanent and successful efforts to promote camping and caravanning as an extremely suitable way to travel, as well as for his solid commitment in partnering with our organization.
